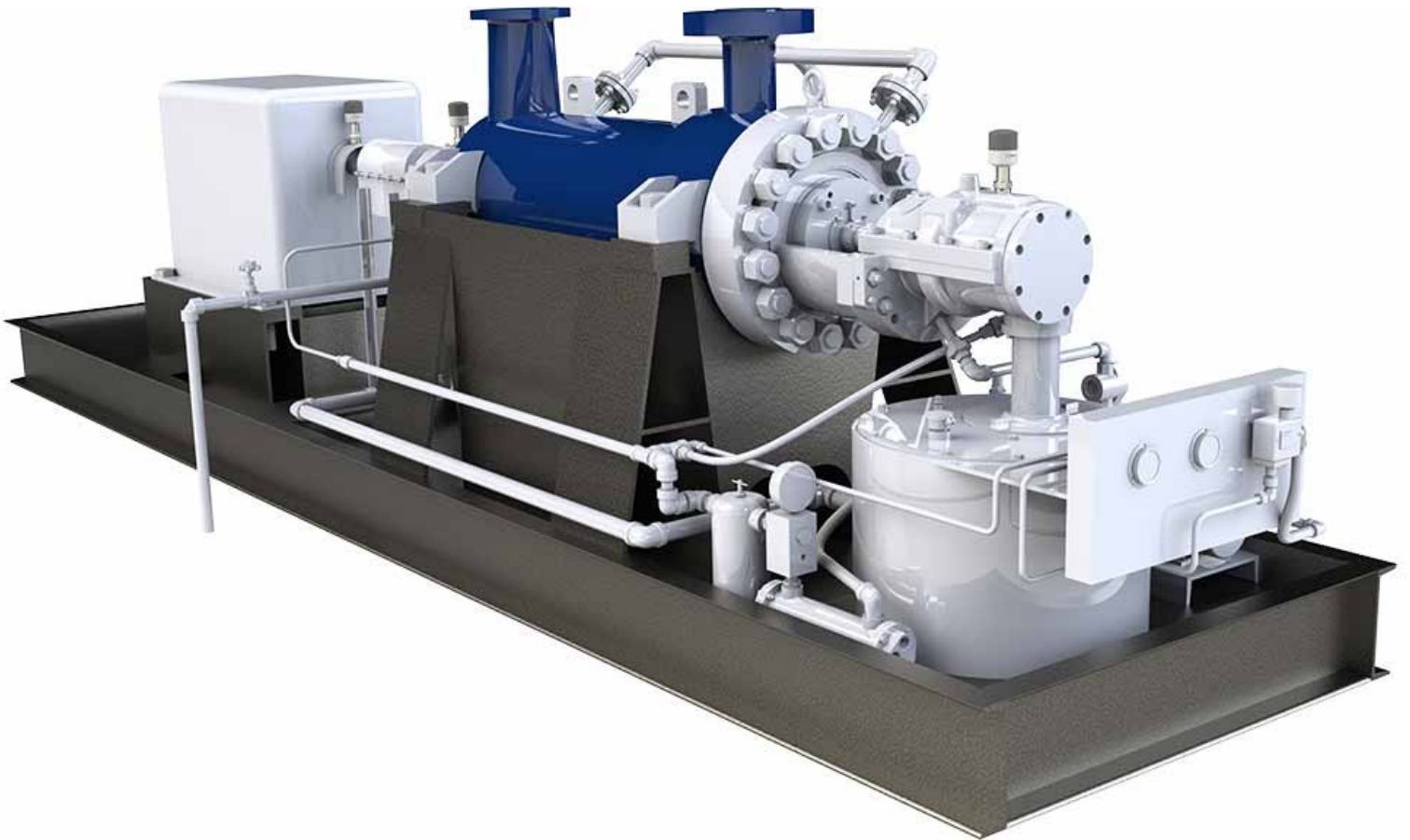




Wireless Sensor Data Integration Into Existing Plant Historian
